Family Race Cost Sheet

Consider the costs below when setting your family's fundraising goal. Look what you could possibly help St. Jude provide for the patients and families of St. Jude.

Infant care supplies for 10 babies: It costs \$50 to provide infant care supplies for 10 babies. These supplies include items like diapers, baby bottles, sippy cups, pacifiers, footies and heel warmers and help parents and nurses care for babies in treatment. - **\$50**

A wagon: Wagons can make traveling through the halls of St. Jude easier for parents and more fun for a young child in treatment. - **\$70**

Celebrate birthdays, holidays and "coming off chemo!" St. Jude provides parties, decorations, cakes and more to keep spirits high during the holidays and to celebrate special times like birthdays and a child's completion of chemotherapy treatment. - **\$75**

Creative toys: Play is an essential part of every child's life and it's important that we offer the opportunity for children to have fun as often as possible. At St. Jude, colorful, toy-filled play areas are just as plentiful as exam rooms. - **\$100**

Chest X-ray, one view: Chest X-rays use high-energy radiation to take pictures of the structures inside the chest. This type of X-ray can be used to detect not only cancer, but also diseases like pneumonia. - **\$320**

Delicious meals: St. Jude provides meal cards so that patients and families can enjoy the comfort and convenience of good, nutritious meals in Kay Kafe, our cafeteria. - **\$210**

Red blood cell transfusion: Platelets and whole blood are essential for treatment of catastrophic diseases. For example, a patient whose treatment involves a bone marrow transplant will typically require 20 units of whole blood and 120 units of platelets during the course of their treatment. - **\$245 per unit**

Physical therapy for one hour: Physical therapy is provided to patients because children with catastrophic diseases like cancer may develop developmental, cognitive or physical impairments as a result of their illnesses and their treatments. - **\$516**

One day of oxygen: Oxygen is key to keeping the immune system strong, helping a young body thrive and fight cancer at the cellular level. - **\$447**

Platelet transfusion: Platelets and whole blood are essential for treatment of catastrophic diseases. For example, during chemotherapy, the platelet count of patients can drop to dangerously low levels. - **\$520 per unit**

Child-sized wheelchairs: These special wheelchairs help children in weakened conditions move easily throughout St. Jude. - **\$700**

One day of chemotherapy: Chemotherapy, which uses drugs to kill cancer cells, is one of the treatments provided at St. Jude. - **avg. \$1,474**

Airfare for a parent and child: St. Jude covers the cost of airfare for a child referred to St. Jude and for one parent or guardian. - **avg. \$1,000**

Ultrasound study: An ultrasound study is among the diagnostic imaging tests that doctors use to diagnose and monitor disease and treatment. - **avg. \$1,248**
